Should you cancel your trip within 72 hours you must get a replacement YOURSELF. Alice will help if there is a waiting list. If you are entitled to a refund, a check will be sent directly to you, not moved to another trip.

Buses will leave from Eveready's/Kohl's parking lot promptly at the announced departure time. Please arrive one half hour before departure.

Day trips are to be paid **EIGHT WEEKS PRIOR TO TRIP**. On overnight trips a \$50.00 deposit will be accepted. Please make out **SEPARATE** checks for each trip.

Your name will be put on a wait list until payment is received. If trips are not filled, you are welcome to bring a friend or relative who will pay the non-member price.

On the day of the trip, Alice will give you your assigned seat. Alice will try to seat you with a friend if you tell her in advance.
